## Younger Than Springtime: Button combining for Accordion

**C<sup>Δ7</sup>** (C Maj7) - *don't play the standard (dominant) 7<sup>th</sup> button!* Combine the C Maj and G Maj chord buttons (Technically this makes a C Maj9 chord – but it's easy to play and sounds good.)

**Dm7** – Combine the D button which is the counter-bass on top of the Bb row with the F major chord button

**G7sus4** – Combine the G7 chord button with the C note button

**Am7** – Combine the A button which is the counter-bass on top of the F row with the C major chord

**Abm7** – Combine the Ab (G#) which is the counter-bass on the E row with the B major chord

**G<sup>6</sup>** - Combine the G major and D major chord buttons (Close, but not exact match!)

**Em7** – Combine the E button which is the counter-bass on top of the C row with the G major chord

**Bm7** – Combine the B button which is the counter-bass on top of the G row with the D major chord

**D<sup>+7</sup>** (also known as D aug) – Combine the D7 button with the Bb/A# note using either the Bb button or the A# which is the counter-bass on the F# row. Either are a stretch, so maybe just play the standard D7 button!

**G<sup>9</sup>** - you could play the G7 chord button, or add the 9<sup>th</sup> by combining the G (or G7) chord button and the A note that is the counter-bass on the F row

**G<sup>7b9</sup>** - you can play the G7 chord button and add Ab or G# note using either the Ab button or the G# note that is the counter-bass on the E row

**C<sup>6</sup>** - Combine the C major and G major chord buttons. (Again, close, but not an exact match!)
